



## Course Overview

This 4-Day Instructor-Led Classroom training intended for project managers who are looking to acquire the Project Management Professional Certification. This training is primarily based on the specifications set forth by PMI and is aligned to the PMBOK.

## Who Should Attend This Course

This course is intended for individuals who wish to obtain their Project Management Professional (PMP)<sup>®</sup> credential. If you are an experienced project manager, who is responsible for key aspects of project delivery, including leading and directing teams, then PMP Certification is right for you.

## Course Outline

- **Day 1** - Introductions, overview of the process for the exam, Professional and Social Responsibility as defined by the PMI Code of Conduct, Project Framework, the 49 processes, and Project Selection and Project Integration Management.
- **Day 2** - Project Stakeholder Management, Project Scope Management and Project Time Management. Project Cost Management begins on day two but does not include covering Earned Value Management.
- **Day 3** - Earned Value Management and Project Quality Management, Project Human Resources Management, and Project Communications Management.
- **Day 4** - Project Risk Management processes and Project Procurement Management. After lunch, we administer a final 2-hour, 100 question practice exam.

The final test score, as well as the 13 section scores, are used to conduct a final Stoplight Assessment with each student. This assessment reviews in class performance and provides an honest feedback about individual readiness to take the exam. Each student is given a guide of what their next steps should be based on the Stoplight Assessment.
